Mission Giving

As our church continues to restructure, so does our mission giving. We have chosen to provide gifts on a quarterly basis. This schedule offers us the opportunity to give locally, nationally, and internationally . . . meeting the needs of people around the world.

One of our primary recipients is Samaritan's Purse. They are a nondenominational evangelical Christian organization providing spiritual and physical aid to hurting people around the world. Since 1970, Samaritan's Purse has helped meet the needs of people who are victims of war, poverty, natural disasters, disease, and famine with the purpose of sharing God's love through his son, Jesus Christ. After sharing the story of the Good Samaritan (Luke 10:30-37), Jesus said "Go and do likewise." That is their mission – to follow the example of Christ by helping those in need and proclaiming the hope of the Gospel.

Our new giving schedule is as follows:

March – Samaritan's Purse US Disaster Relief

Without fail, disasters will come. Hurricanes, tornadoes, fires, and floods strike communities in the United States every year. They provide services free of charge to help families rebuild after a crisis occurs. Our gifts support their efforts to repair roofs, remove debris, and even rebuild homes from the ground up in the name of Jesus Christ.

June – Lewiston Community Sharing

The purpose of this local organization is to secure, hold, distribute and administer aid in the form of food, clothing, household goods, and other emergency needs in the communities of Lewiston-Johannesburg and other surrounding areas.

September – Samaritan's Purse Global Mission

For over 50 years, they have done their utmost to follow Christ's command by going to the aid of the world's poor, sick, and suffering. Our gifts ensure that teams will be able to reach hurting people in countries around the world with food, medicine, and other assistance to those with unfathomable needs.

December – Operation Christmas Child

Samaritan's Purse sends gift-filled shoe boxes to children in need around the world together with the message of the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

After a successful first round interview with the Search Team on Wednesday, June 18th, Pastor Derek Whitacre has been invited to a few more events. Please attend the ones that are open to the congregation (in bold) if you are able. Here is the schedule:

-The week of June 23rd, Pastor Derek is interviewing with Pastor Jon Sherrill (Fifth Reformed Church in Grand Rapids), Pastor Tim Thompson (Joburg Christian Church), and Rick Zomer, a friend with church leadership experience.

- **Saturday, June 28, at 1:00 PM**, Pastor Derek will be at the church to give his background and answer questions. After he is done, we will seek feedback from the congregation.

- **Sunday, June 29**, Pastor Derek will deliver the sermon at 10am service. I will dismiss him and his wife Deanna downstairs and seek feedback from the congregation. We will then join them downstairs for Community Time so others can get to know them and ask any more questions.

- Monday, June 30, at 9:00 AM, the Search Team, Board of Diaconate, and Board of Trustees will meet to review feedback and decide on the next steps.

- If we reach a positive conclusion, we will wait a week, pray, and seek additional feedback from the congregation. Following that, we will meet to confirm our decision.

- If our recommendation is positive, the Search Team will meet the following Sunday (or next, because that is the 4th holiday weekend), to present our recommendation, and ask for a vote.

Library – Featured Book Because He Lives by Gloria Gaither


